Aquatic Center Kiddie Pool Liner Repair Project

Sealed proposals will be received until 2:00PM Central Daylight Time, December 20th, 2018, at the City of Panama City Beach City Hall Annex, 110 S Arnold Road, Panama City Beach, Florida 32413 and will be opened and publicly read immediately thereafter. All Bids shall be submitted in an envelope clearly marked "Sealed Bid- Panama City Beach – "Aquatic Center Kiddie Pool Liner Repair Project".

Proposals must be submitted upon the standard form contained in the Specifications with such attachments as may be authorized there.

The City reserves the right to (1) reject any and all bids and to waive any informality in bids received, and (2) to award the contract to a bidder other than the lowest bidder should it find that the lowest bidder does not offer the reliability, quality of service or product afforded by such other bidder. Where a bid other than the lowest bid is taken, the City Council will state the reasons upon which such award was made. All bidders shall comply with all applicable state and local laws concerning licensing, registration, and regulations of businesses in the state of Florida.

All Bids shall be firm for a period of 60 days after opening.

Parks & Recreation Aquatic Center Kiddie Pool Liner Repair Project

PART 1 - GENERAL SPECIFICATIONS

- A. The scope of work entails the preparation and installation of the following project:
 - 1. The Aquatic Center "Kiddie Pool" To remove the old Pool Liner and replace with a new Pool Liner.
 - 2. When removing the Pool Liner in the Kiddie Pool to remove all Play Features. Attachment B
 - 3. When replacing the Pool Liner in the Kiddie Pool, to install the main Play Feature back in place and to install (2 to 4) new play features to be provided by the City. These play features will use the existing plumbing holes. The City will purchase the new Kiddie Pool Play features. The possible new play features are listed on Attachment C.
 - 4. If the City does not have the new Kiddie Pool Play Features available for the installation, the contractor will put the old play features back in. It is the City's responsible to purchase the new play features and have available for the install.

B. General: Materials

The City will drain the Kiddie Pool prior to the day you show up to complete the job.

Upon completion, the Contractor shall remove all containers, surplus materials and debris, and leave the site in a clean and orderly condition acceptable to the Owner.

- C. Provide a 1 year Warranty starting on March 1, 2019 on labor, materials & workmanship on Kiddie Pool Liner Repairs and Installation of Play Features. Also, will provide a minimum of a 5 year Warranty on the New Kiddie Pool Liner.
- D. The Liner Membrane must be a product accepted by City and have a success record of a minimum of (3) of the listed references on the Bid Form. The City reserves the right to reject the proposed Kiddie Pool Liner if it is believed the Kiddie Pool Liners is a product not of good quality for a Public Kiddie Pool.
- E. The Preferred color of the Liner is to be a Light Blue. However, White Liners are acceptable.
- F. The City is tax exempt and a copy of certificate of exemption is attached as Exhibit A.
- G. After the project is complete, payment in full will be made within 30 days of receipt of invoice for the approved bid amount. Invoice shall be submitted in digital Adobe Acrobat pdf format to Cheryl Joyner Recreation Administration Supervisor at cjoyner@pcbgov.com.
- H. Bidder shall obtain any and all permits from the City Planning Dept before project begins.
- I. Job Completion will be completed by Monday March 4, 2019 with liquidated damages of \$300.00 per day thereafter.

PART 2 – MINIMUM BIDDER QUALIFICATIONS

The proposal must include verifiable evidence and references demonstrating that the Bidder's personnel responsible for this project meet the following:

- A. On site supervision by a person with at least three years of experience in Pool Liners and the installation of the recommended material..
- B. Company experience and a list of references on at least (3) projects of similar size, type and complexity.
- C. Bidder must have ten (10) years minimum experience in Liner Replacements and Repairs.

 Upon request, Bidder must present a minimum of fifteen (15) Liner projects completed during the past five (5) years.



Important Information for Exempt Organizations

DR-14 R. 10/15

- 1. You must provide all vendors and suppliers with an exemption certificate before making tax-exempt purchases. See Rule 12A-1.038, Florida Administrative Code (F.A.C.).
- 2. Your Consumer's Certificate of Exemption is to be used solely by your organization for your organization's customary nonprofit activities.
- 3. Purchases made by an individual on behalf of the organization are taxable, even if the individual will be reimbursed by the organization.
- 4. This exemption applies only to purchases your organization makes. The sale or lease to others of tangible personal property, sleeping accommodations, or other real property is taxable. Your organization must register, and collect and remit sales and use tax on such taxable transactions. Note: Churches are exempt from this requirement except when they are the lessor of real property (Rule 12A-1.070, F.A.C.).
- 5. It is a criminal offense to fraudulently present this certificate to evade the payment of sales tax. Under no circumstances should this certificate be used for the personal benefit of any individual. Violators will be liable for payment of the sales tax plus a penalty of 200% of the tax, and may be subject to conviction of a third-degree felony. 


