TOTE HOLDINGS, LLC, et al*, to acquire property for the City's Front Beach Road Segment 3 project, in substantially the form attached and presented to the Council today, draft dated October 5, 2020.

THIS RESOLUTION shall be effective immediately upon passage.



AFTER MEDIATION, THE PARTIES AGREE AS FOLLOWS:

- (1) THE CITY OF PANAMA CITY BEACH (HEREIN AFTER CITY)
SHALL PAY THE TOTAL SUM OF \$ 462,500⁰⁰ IN SATISFACTION
OF ANY AND ALL CLAIMS FOR PROPERTY, SEVERANCE, BUSINESS OR ANY
OTHER DAMAGES RELATED TO CITY'S ACQUISITION OF PARCEL
32779. CITY WILL DEPOSIT THAT AMOUNT INTO THE REGISTRY
OF THE COURT WITHIN 30 DAYS OF THE ORDER OF TAKING.
- (2) THE CITY SHALL PAY THE TOTAL SUM OF \$ 3,500,000.00
IN SATISFACTION OF ANY AND ALL CLAIMS FOR PROPERTY, SEVERANCE,
BUSINESS OR ANY OTHER DAMAGES RELATED TO CITY'S ACQUISITION
OF PARCEL # 32780. CITY WILL DEPOSIT THAT SUM INTO THE
REGISTRY OF THE COURT WITHIN 30 DAYS OF THE ORDER OF TAKING.

- (3) THE CITY WILL EXTEND POSSESSION OF THE PREMISES ON PARCEL
32780 TO THE CURRENT OCCUPANT UNTIL CITY PROVIDES 30
DAYS NOTICE TO QUIT, WHICH SHALL BE LESS THAN 5 MONTHS
FROM THE DATE OF THIS AGREEMENT. OCCUPANT AGREES TO
INCLUSION OF A CLAUSE IN THE ORDER OF TAKING TO ALLOW
THE COURT TO GRANT AN EX PARTE' WRIT TO REMOVE ANY
HOLDOVER OCCUPANT. DURING THE TERM OF THE EXTENDED
POSSESSION OCCUPANT SHALL ADD CITY AS AN ADDITIONAL INSURED
ON ITS LIABILITY POLICY AND PROVIDE PROOF OF SAME TO CITY
COUNSEL.
- (4) THE PARTIES ACKNOWLEDGE THERE ARE UNRESOLVED
APPORTIONMENT ISSUES. THE DEFENDANTS SHALL:
 - (A) SEEK APPORTIONMENT OPINIONS FROM THEIR RESPECTIVE
APPRAISERS WITHIN 60 DAYS OF THIS AGREEMENT

- B) DEFENDANTS SHALL MEDIATE ANY APPORTIONMENTS THAT ARE UNRESOLVED WITHIN 30 DAYS AFTER RECEIPT OF THE OPINIONS IN (4)(A) ABOVE.
- C) IF PARTIES MUST SEEK COURT ACTION TO RESOLVE ANY APPORTIONMENT ISSUE, COUNSEL FOR TOTE HOLDINGS LLC AGREES TO LIMIT ~~THE~~ ATTORNEY'S FEES TO A MAXIMUM OF \$25,000.00

(5) DEFENDANTS WAIVE ANY OBJECTIONS TO THE ORDER OF TAKING TO BE ENTERED BY THE COURT ON FRIDAY, OCTOBER 9TH 2020. WITHIN 30 DAYS OF THIS AGREEMENT THE PARTIES SHALL SUBMIT A STIPULATED FINAL JUDGEMENT TO THE COURT IN A FORM ACCEPTABLE TO COUNSEL.

(6) THE PARTIES ACKNOWLEDGE THAT THIS AGREEMENT IS CONTINGENT UPON CITY COUNCIL APPROVAL. STAFF SHALL RECOMMEND APPROVAL ON OCTOBER 8, 2020.

(7) COUNSEL FOR DEFENDANTS ARE ENTITLED TO A STATUTORY FEE IN THE AMOUNT #210,625⁰⁰ TO BE PAID BY CITY TO THE TRUST ACCOUNT OF CHARLES FORMAN, ESQ. WITHIN 30 DAYS OF THIS AGREEMENT

(8) THE EXISTING LEASES BETWEEN THE PARTIES SHALL REMAIN IN EFFECT ~~DURING~~ DURING OCCUPANT'S EXTENDED POSSESSION
