**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF PANAMA CITY BEACH, FLORIDA,
RECOGNIZING THE CONTRIBUTION OF ROBERT A. CARLSON, III, TO
THE CITY'S TENNIS PROGRAM AND NAMING IN HIS HONOR THE
TENNIS COURTS AT FRANK BROWN PARK.**

WHEREAS, the late Robert A. Carlson, III moved to Panama City Beach in 2006;
and

WHEREAS, as the Tennis Pro at Frank Brown Park since 2008, "Coach Rob"
taught thousands of City and Bay County residents in various tennis programs at Frank
Brown Park; and

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to confirm the legacy of Robert Carlson in our
community by naming the tennis courts at Frank Brown Park in his honor.


NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that henceforth the tennis courts at Frank
Brown Park shall be known to all persons as the ROBERT CARLSON Tennis Courts,
and, shall be affectionately known to all persons as "CARLSON'S COURTS." Park
Management is instructed to place and maintain permanent signs on the courts and in
the Park prominently announcing these names.

THIS RESOLUTION shall become effective immediately upon passage.
