PCB21-14 RFP 9-1-1 RECORDING SOLUTIONS

Questions

- 1. The RFP requires recording Harris Radio channels. However, it does not specify whether you require a "Full Harris Integration" or just an "Analog Output". There is a difference in the data that's captured (recorded) as well as a cost difference. The Full Harris Integration provides all of the meta-data from the radios. Example: The radio alias.
 - a. We require Analog Output
- 2. How long does the city retain its audio recordings?
 - a. One year.
- 3. Does the city have a Network Attached storage location for redundant storage of recordings beyond the single copy of the call recorder?
 - a. No.

If not, should one be proposed?

- b. No.
- 4. What radio system is the city using?
 - a. Harris Communications / Symphony Consoles
- 5. Are the 6 radio channels to be recorded analog outputs from the Harris Symphony consoles, analog outputs from other devices, trunks from a radio system or something else. If other devices, please identify what is providing the output to the recorder, and how it is being delivered to the VPI Empower.
 - a. Yes, analog.
- 6. How are the E-911 trunks recorded today? Analog tap?

- a. Current vendor / program. Yes, analog.
- 7. Is there a 911 PBX currently in use? If so, what system.
 - a. No.
- 8. Is there a CAD system currently in use? If so, what system.
 - a. USA Software.
- 9. Is the city open to recording items differently, such as console recording instead of 911 trunk recording?
 - a. Yes.
- 10. Is ANI/ALI from a DB9 serial feed available?
 - a. No.
