RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING CITY OF PANAMA CITY BEACH, FLORIDA TO APPROVE COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT-DISASTER RECOVERY APPLICATION TO BE SUBMITTED FOR FUNDING TO THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF ECONOMIC OPPORTUNITY REBUILD FLORIDA HURRICANE MICHAEL PROGRAM; AND COMMITTING FUNDS FOR LOCAL MATCH.

WHEREAS, Hurricane Michael devastated Bay County and the surrounding area on October 10, 2018; and

WHEREAS, City of Panama City Beach, Florida, is submitting a project application for the Conversion of Septic to Sanitary Sewer System at South Grand Lagoon Project (the "Project") to the State of Florida, Department of Economic Opportunity (DEO) for potential Community Development Block Grant-Disaster Recovery (CDBG-DR) funding through the Rebuild Florida General Infrastructure Repair Program.

WHEREAS, the City of Panama City Beach proposes to leverage approximately \$5,500,000 from the Utilities Department budget as a voluntary CDBG-DR project match.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the City Council of the City of Panama City Beach, Florida, that:

- The City Manager is authorized to execute and deliver on behalf of the City, the application for CDBG-DR funding for the Project, and to provide any necessary documentation supporting such applications to DEO or any other relevant agencies, as requested and required.
- 2. The City commits to provide \$5,500,000 in matching funds for the Project.
- 3. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon passage.
