## **RESOLUTION NO. 23-103**

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF PANAMA CITY BEACH, FLORIDA, APPROVING AN AGREEMENT WITH MAINLINE CONSTRUCTION, LLC RELATING TO THE STREET DRAINAGE PIPE PROJECT FOR THE PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT, IN THE BASIC AMOUNT OF \$493,188.98; AND AUTHORIZING A CONTINGENCY FOR UNFORESEEN CIRCUMSTANCES AND UNDER CERTAIN CONDITIONS IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$24,659.45.

## BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PANAMA CITY BEACH, FLORIDA THAT:

- 1. The appropriate officers of the City are authorized to execute and deliver on behalf of the City that certain Agreement between the City and Mainline Construction, LLC, relating to the Gardenia Street Drainage Pipe Project in the basic amount of Four Hundred Ninety-Three Thousand, One Hundred Eighty-Eight Dollars and Ninety-Eight Cents (\$493,188.98), in substantially the form attached as Exhibit A and presented to the Council today, with such changes, insertions or omissions as may be approved by the City Manager and whose execution shall be conclusive evidence of such approval.
- 2. The City Manager is authorized to execute and deliver on behalf of the City change orders for unforeseen conditions related to this Project, in a cumulative amount that does not exceed Twenty-Four Thousand, Six Hundred Fifty-Nine Dollars and Forty-Five Cents (\$24,659.45), provided that the Public Works Director certifies that the change order does not result in a fundamental change to the scope of the project or the standard of materials used for such, the Finance Director confirms the contingency amount set forth herein is not exceeded, and the City Attorney has reviewed the form of the change order.

THIS RESOLUTION shall be effective immediately upon passage.
