

RESOLUTION NO. 23-188

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF PANAMA CITY BEACH, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING A BUDGET AMENDMENT TO APPROPRIATE ADDITIONAL FUNDS FOR THE RELOCATION OF UTILITIES ON FDOT'S ROAD WIDENING PROJECT ON PANAMA CITY BEACH PARKWAY BETWEEN NAUTILUS ROAD AND R. JACKSON BOULEVARD.

WHEREAS, on January 26, 2023, the Council adopted Resolution 23-96, which approved an Agreement between the City and FDOT regarding the relocation of City utilities necessitated by FDOT's road widening project on Panama City Beach Parkway between Nautilus Road and R. Jackson Boulevard, at the City's expense; and

WHEREAS, the City budgeted funds for this purpose, based on the estimates provided by FDOT in that Agreement; and

WHEREAS, the actual costs for the work based on bids received exceed the amounts budgeted, such that additional funds are necessary to fully fund this portion of the project.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the following budget amendment #44 is adopted for the City of Panama City Beach, Florida, for the fiscal year beginning October 1, 2022 and ending September 30, 2023, in accordance with the **attached** and incorporated Exhibit A.


THIS RESOLUTION shall be effective immediately upon passage.
