

RESOLUTION NO. 23-192

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF PANAMA CITY BEACH,
FLORIDA, SUPPLEMENTING RESOLUTION 23-29 TO
EXTEND THE SUNSET DATE OF THE FRONT BEACH ROAD
PARKING AND MOBILITY STEERING COMMITTEE.**

WHEREAS, on October 27, 2022, the Council adopted Resolution 23-29 which established an advisory committee to provide recommendation and guidance regarding parking and mobility strategies to advance the execution of goals and objective of the Front Beach Road Community Redevelopment Plan; and

WHEREAS, at the first meeting of the Committee it was determined that the City's peak parking month was July, and that data from that month should be included in the study for which the Committee's recommendations will be derived; and

WHEREAS, staff recommends that the September 2023 sunset proposed in Resolution 23-29 be extended so that July data may be included and with sufficient time for it to be properly evaluated and considered by the Committee.

BE IT RESOLVED that Resolution 23-29 is hereby supplemented to extend the duration of the Front Beach Road Parking and Mobility Steering Committee to June 30, 2024.

THIS RESOLUTION shall be effective immediately upon passage.

7. BACKGROUND: WHY IS THE ACTION NECESSARY? WHAT GOAL WILL BE ACHIEVED?

In October 2022, the Council adopted Resolution 23-28 approving a work order with the Corradino Group for the development of a parking and mobility plan for the Front Beach Road CRA. The first task under that work order's scope of services was the establishment of a steering committee to guide the overall direction of the work, to assist with permissions for data collection on private or public properties, and to facilitate consensus toward implementation of the recommendations of the study. The steering committee was established via Resolution 23-29. Part D of that Resolution addresses the duration and sunset of the committee: "The Committee shall automatically dissolve upon completion of the CRA Parking and Mobility Plan or September 2023, whichever occurs first; unless earlier extended by Resolution of the City Council."

At the initial meeting of the steering committee, lodging industry representatives indicated that they believed the peak "parking" month which should be included in the survey was July. City revenue collections support that conclusion. As a result of the information received at that meeting, management directed Corradino to extend the project timeline to ensure that July parking data was included in the study. The revised schedule is included in the agenda packet indicating a completion date of February 2024. As a result of the extended project timeline, it is necessary to extend the "life" of the steering committee which will automatically sunset in September 2023 prior to project completion.

Staff recommends approval of Resolution No. 23-192 which extends the duration of the steering committee to June 30, 2024.
